Lime Tree Lane accepts bookings subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Arrangements & Conditions:**

All arrangements are made subject to the following terms and conditions. The contract is between Lime Tree Lane and the Client, ('being all persons named on the booking form attending or intending to attend a Lime Tree Lane class'). The person signing the booking form (which incorporates these terms) warrants that he/she has full authority to do so on behalf of all persons whose names appear thereon, and confirms that all such persons are fully aware of and accept these conditions.
- 2. Making a booking:**

To secure a booking with Lime Tree Lane and our suppliers requires a completed and signed booking form. All payments should be made in full at the time of booking for the class. Upon the successful receipt of your payment and booking form, you will receive confirmation of your place by email, to your nominated email address, fax or by your given postal address.
- 3. Payment:**

We do not take provisional bookings and cannot confirm your place on a class until we receive full payment. Your place will only be confirmed when we are in receipt of your completed booking form and accompanied full payment. Please fill in the form and either post it with a cheque to Lime Tree Lane Caribbean Dining, 34 Bent Lane, Rushmere St Andrew, HA4 0UB or fax to +44 (0) 872 111 4691 or request our BACS details. Payments made by cheque require 7 working days for clearance.
- 4. Cancellation Terms:**

No refunds will be given where clients cancel their attendance giving less than 14 working days notice. A minimum of 12 participants (maximum of 18) is required per date. Should this not be achieved, Lime Tree Lane reserves the right to cancel the event and either reschedule or refund all monies paid.
- 5. Changes by Us:**

From time to time, due to circumstances beyond our control, we may have to reschedule an event date. Should this situation arise, all clients will be notified and an alternative offered.
- 6. What's included:**

Ingredients, utensils, knives, equipment and aprons are provided for all classes. Some meals are included in the classes cost - please see appropriate class details for further information.
- 7. What's not included:**

Transportation to & from the venue, bar beverages or laundry.
- 8. Application requirements:**

You must be 18 years or over to attend our cookery classes.
- 9. Skill Level:**

All abilities welcome.
- 10. Health & Safety:**

All participants should wear shoes with flat, non-slip soles and covered toes, preferably leather. We cannot admit you to the cookery school without proper footwear. We recommend wearing sensible clothing - we are not liable for any damage that occurs to clothing. Long hair must be tied back in the kitchen. All class participants will receive a short briefing on health and safety before commencing the class.
- 11. Special dietary requirements, food allergies & illness:**

We are unable to tailor our class content for special dietary requirements unless you are booking a minimum of 10 places on the class. However, we will be happy to discuss class content beforehand to allow you to make your own alternative eating arrangements if necessary. There is no reduction in fee in this instance. Please inform us in advance of any allergies, disabilities, diabetes, pregnancy, epilepsy, learning difficulties etc.
- 12. If you have a Complaint:**

If the Client has a complaint about any of Lime Tree Lane's holiday arrangements, the Client must bring it to the attention of the representative of Lime Tree Lane at the time so that they may use their best endeavours to rectify the situation. It is only if we are made aware of any problems that there will be the opportunity to put things right. Failure to complain on the spot will result in the Client's ability to claim compensation from Lime Tree Lane being nullified or at least reduced. In the event of a claim, our maximum liability is restricted to the total amount paid to us by the claimant less any expenses incurred. Should the problem remain unsolved a complaint must be made in writing to Lime Tree Lane within 28 days of the completion of the class.
- 13. Jurisdiction - Governing Law:**

This contract, including all matters arising from it, is subject to English Law and the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
